GATEWAY ENERGY HELPING PENNSYLVANIA JOB-SEEKERS

MONTEBELLO, NY - Gateway Energy Services is offering support and encouragement to job-seekers in Northeastern Pennsylvania by holding two job fairs and a résumé-writing workshop.

On Tuesday, April 13, Gateway will attend The Mohegan Sun Arena at Casey Plaza Job Fair from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. The event is hosted by the Greater Wilkes-Barre Chamber in collaboration with the Greater Scranton, Hazelton and Pittston Chambers of Commerce, the Great Valley Technology Alliance, the Lackawanna County and Luzerne/Schuylkill County Workforce Investment Boards and The Times-Tribune, The Citizen's Voice and The Northeast Business Journal. Attendees will have the opportunity to meet with potential employers as well as attend workshops.

Gateway recruiter George Bellog will hold a résumé-writing workshop at the job fair to offer jobseekers tips and tricks for landing the interview. During the 45-minute workshop, he will:

- Go over sample résumés to show what works and what doesn't
- Discuss the parts of a good résumé, from content, order and length, to style and formats.
- Discuss cover letters, their usage and content.
- Discuss why you should have various versions of your résumé.
- Discuss what not to include on your résumé, such as personal information
- Moderate a question-and-answer session and provide feedback, including helpful Web sites.

Also on April 13, Gateway will host a Job Fair from 3 to 7 p.m. at its satellite office at 190 Welles St., Forty Fort. The energy marketer is hiring approximately 15 experienced Outbound Telemarketing Sales Representatives (OTMs) and Residential Sales Representatives for the Allentown, Scranton and Wilkes-Barre areas. The hiring is the latest step in Gateway's commitment to do its part to help bring the economy back from crisis. Gateway had previously announced that it would create up to 100 new jobs by the end of the year. So far, the company has hired 49.

Gateway began offering power to customers in the PPL service area on January 16, resulting in the most successful launch in its 12-year history. Gateway offers a competitive fixed-rate plan, available through the end of 2010. It also offers one- and two-year fixed-rate plans, as well as a variable-rate plan that reflects market prices.
